Home Start Behavior Services are:

- Grant Funded by the Child Abuse Treatment Program, Grossmont Healthcare District, and San Diego Community Development Block Grant.
- Provided by trained therapists and typically lasts approx. six months.
- Provided in Office, Home, School, or Telehealth Video.
- Available in English & Spanish.

## Available Services:

- Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (15m-7y)
- Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy 2. Must have experienced a form of
- Cognitive Processing Therapy
- Play Therapy
- Family Therapy



## Qualifications:

- 1. Children are under the age of 18
  - Must have experienced a form of abuse/trauma. Including, but not limited to:
    - a. Neglect
    - b. Physical, Sexual, or Emotional Abuse
    - c. Parental Substance Abuse
    - d. Witnessed/Experienced Domestic Violence
    - e. Child Abduction
    - f. Bullying/School or Community Violence
    - g. Hate Crime
- 3. Unable to obtain services through insurance
  - a. Unable to pay fees
  - b. No provider in area
  - c. Bad exp. with insurance providers
  - d. Transportation Challenges
  - e. No Insurance
